

UPDATE ON PLAYGROUND SANITATION:

TOWN OF ST. STEPHEN TO CONTINUE CURRENT SANITATION PROCEDURES

Please be advised that the Town of St. Stephen recently received correspondence from the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health indicating that municipalities are not required to undertake sanitation of playground equipment.

Having considered this new information, the Town of St. Stephen has determined that it would be in the best interest of our community to continue with the twice daily sanitation schedule at this time. As such we ask the public to continue to respect the following park closures to assist our team in their efforts to enhance the safety of these facilities:

Skate Park Elm Park Playground Abbot St. Park	<u>9am to 10am</u> <u>&</u> <u>3pm to 4pm</u>
Chocolate Park Playground Splashpad	<u>8am to 9am</u> <u>&</u> <u>2pm to 3pm</u>

Despite our efforts to make these areas as safe as possible, all users are hereby notified of the following:

1. Use of the facility during its open hours is at the user's risk;
2. Users are strongly encouraged to practice good personal hygiene, including hand washing or sanitizing before and after using the equipment, benches, etc.;
3. Users are strongly encouraged to practice good social distancing while using the facility;
