NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING (New Rescheduled Date)

The Council of the Town of St. Stephen, in compliance with *Section 111 of the Community Planning Act* of the Province of New Brunswick, intends to hold a Public Hearing of Objections and/or Comments for the proposed **Municipal Plan By-law No. M-2-01** and **Zoning By-law No. Z-2-01 on Wednesday June 30**th, **2021**, **starting at 5:00 P.M.**

The proposed **Municipal Plan By-law No. M-2-01** and **Zoning By-law No. Z-2-01** are by-laws to amend the municipal plan's generalized future land use map and the zoning by-law's zoning map which affect a portion of property at 84 Prince William Street. The by-laws would change a portion of land from Industrial to Residential designation in the municipal plan and from Light Industrial "I-2" Zone to Multiple Unit Residential "R-3" Zone in the zoning by-law. This by-law change would facilitate the development of two (2) twelve (12) unit apartment buildings.
