## BYLAW NO. A-6

## A BYLAW TO REPEAL SEVERAL BYLAWS OF THE TOWN OF ST. STEPHEN

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. STEPHEN AS FOLLOWS:

- The following bylaws, enacted by the Town of St. Stephen and amendments 1. thereto, are hereby repealed:
- (i) Bylaw No. 83-1, A Bylaw To Facilitate Metric Conversion, adopted March 21, 1983;
- Bylaw No. 87-2, A Bylaw To Regulate The Opening Of Retail Businesses Within (ii) The Town of St. Stephen, adopted May 19, 1987;
- (iii) Bylaw No. 88-4, A Bylaw To Stop-Up And Close A Portion Of Chocolate Drive Lying On The Easterly Side of King Street, adopted August 15, 1988;
- (iv) By-Law 92-1, A Bylaw Respecting and License Places of Amusement, adopted July 20, 1972.
- Bylaw No. 92-2, A Bylaw Respecting The Penalties For Bylaw Offences, adopted July 20, 1992;
- Bylaw No. 01-08, A Bylaw To Amend Bylaw No. 86-2, A Bylaw Respecting Fire Protection For The Town of St. Stephen, adopted October 15, 2001.
- The repeal of the said bylaws shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat or disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.
