BY-LAW NO. T-3

A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE A PORTION OF LISGAR STREET

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of The Town of St. Stephen as follows:

All those certain portions of Lisgar Street, so called, in The Town of St. Stephen, in the County of Charlotte, hereinafter bounded and described, are hereby permanently stopped up and closed and shall no longer be public thoroughfares:

- 1. Beginning at a point where the arc of a curve intersects the west side of Lisgar Street, said point having New Brunswick grid coordinate values (NAD 83) of easting 2439020.806 metres and northing 7356010.203 metres; thence northerly and northeasterly along the arc of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 12.00 metres (chord equivalent having a distance of 18.54 metres measured on a New Brunswick grid azimuth of 8 degrees, 22 minutes and 50 seconds), a distance of 21.19 metres to a point on said curve; thence on a New Brunswick grid azimuth of 188 degrees, 22 minutes and 40 seconds, a distance of 18.54 metres to the place of beginning. A tract of land containing an area of 56 square metres and being shown as "Portion of Lisgar Street, a Public Street" and being that half moon portion lying west of Lisgar Street being more particularly shown on a Plan of Survey showing Portion of Lisgar Street, Town of St. Stephen, Charlotte County. New Brunswick prepared by Hughes Surveys & Consultants Inc. and dated May 11, 2006, a reduced copy of which being hereto attached.
- 2. Beginning at a point on a curve at the intersection of the east side of Lisgar Street with the northern boundary of Lot 96-1 shown on Charlotte County Plan #200458, said point having New Brunswick grid coordinate values (NAD 83) of easting 2439035.882 metres and northing 7356007.982 metres; thence on a New Brunswick grid azimuth of 8 degrees, 22 minutes and 40 seconds, a distance of 18.54 metres to a point on a curve on the limits of Lisgar Street; thence southerly and southwesterly along the arc of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 12.00 metres (chord equivalent being a distance of 18.54 metres measured on a New Brunswick grid azimuth of 188 degrees, 22 minutes and 50 seconds), a distance of 21.19 metres to the place of beginning. A tract of land containing an area of 56 square metres and being shown as "Portion of Lisgar Street, a Public Street" and being that half moon portion lying east of Lisgar Street being more particularly shown on a Plan of Survey showing Portion of Lisgar Street, Town of St. Stephen. Charlotte County, New Brunswick prepared by Hughes Surveys & Consultants Inc. and dated May 11, 2006, a reduced copy of which being hereto attached.



Beginning at a point on a curve at the intersection of the east side of Lisgar Street with the northern boundary of Lot 96-1 shown on Charlotte County Plan #200458, said point having New Brunswick grid coordinate values (NAD 83) of easting 2439035.882 metres and northing 7356007.982 metres; thence on a New Brunswick grid azimuth of 8 degrees, 22 minutes and 40 seconds, a distance of 18.54 metres to a point on a curve on the limits of Lisgar Street; thence southerly and southwesterly along the arc of a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 12.00 metres (chord equivalent being a distance of 18.54 metres measured on a New Brunswick grid azimuth of 188 degrees, 22 minutes and 50 seconds), a distance of 21.19 metres to the place of beginning. A tract of land containing an area of 56 square metres and being shown as "Portion of Lisgar Street, a Public Street" and being that half moon portion lying east of Lisgar Street being more particularly shown on a Plan of Survey showing Portion of Lisgar Street, Town of St. Stephen, Charlotte County, New Brunswick prepared by Hughes Surveys & Consultants Inc. and dated May 11, 2006, a reduced copy of which being hereto attached.
