A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE A PORTION OF PROGRESS DRIVE

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of The Town of St. Stephen as follows:

All that certain portion of Progress Drive, so called, in The Town of St. Stephen, in the County of Charlotte, hereinafter bounded and described, is hereby permanently stopped up and closed and shall no longer be a public thoroughfare:

1. Beginning at the northwest corner of lands of Richard Pierce Ltd., PID No. 15170848, being a calculated point numbered 121 on a Plan of Survey showing a portion of a public street to be stopped up prepared by Murphy Surveys (1990) Ltd. and dated April 3, 2007, a reduced copy of which being hereto attached; thence 138° 07' 14" along the northerly sideline of said Pierce lands a distance of 62.060 metres to point numbered 172 on said Plan; thence 48° 07' 04" a distance of 20.118 metres to point numbered 167 on said Plan; thence 318° 07' 14" a distance of 65.350 metres to point numbered 110 on said Plan; thence 218° 49' 45" a distance of 20.385 metres to the place of beginning and containing an area of 1,282 square metres and being shown as Parcel "A" on said Plan.
