NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Council of the Town of St. Stephen, in compliance with *Section 111 of the Community Planning Act* of the Province of New Brunswick, intends to hold a Public Hearing of Objections and/or Comments for the proposed **Town of St. Stephen Secondary Municipal Plan By-law No. M-3** on Wednesday May 25th, 2022, starting at 5:00 P.M.

This draft Secondary Plan has been prepared in accordance with section 29 through 31 of the *Community Planning Act*. It focuses primarily on guiding development and expansion of the Industrial Park while providing Town Council with long-term planning policies for the Industrial Park under the guidance of the Town of St. Stephen Municipal Plan By-law No. M-2 and is informed by the background study, the St. Stephen Business Park Functional Plan (December, 2021) prepared by Dillon Consulting Inc. with guidance and close-support from Future St. Stephen.
