160/20 **THAT** the sum of \$9,470,790 (nine million, four hundred and seventy thousand, seven hundred and ninety dollars) be the total operating budget of the local government, that the sum of \$5,523,832 (five million, five hundred and twenty three thousand, eight hundred and thirty two dollars) be the Warrant of the local government for the ensuing year, and that the tax rate for the local government be \$1.5800 (one dollar and fifty-eight cents.)

The Council orders and directs the levying by the Minister of Environment and Local Government of said amount on real property liable to taxation under the *Assessment Act* within the local government of St. Stephen. **CARRIED**

2021 WATER AND SEWERAGE OPERATING FUND BUDGET
