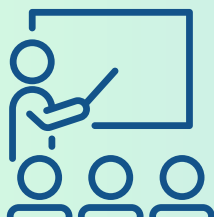
Largest Program in the under 20,000 population category

SWIMMING LESSONS

In 2023, we taught 341 children to swim. So far in 2024, we have already taught 188, with 4 more sessions to go this year! This means that, in 2024, we have already reached 55% of last years' swimming lesson numbers in just TWO SESSIONS!

HOW DOES THIS COMPARE TO 2022 & 2023?

This is a significant step forward for our department when compared to 2022. In 2022, our department did not rank in the overall category, and ranked 5th in the under 20,000 category, with no ranking in leadership either. This represents a significant increase in training and course registration. So far, in 2024, we are already well on track to surpass both our swimming lessons numbers and our training numbers from both 2022, and 2023.
