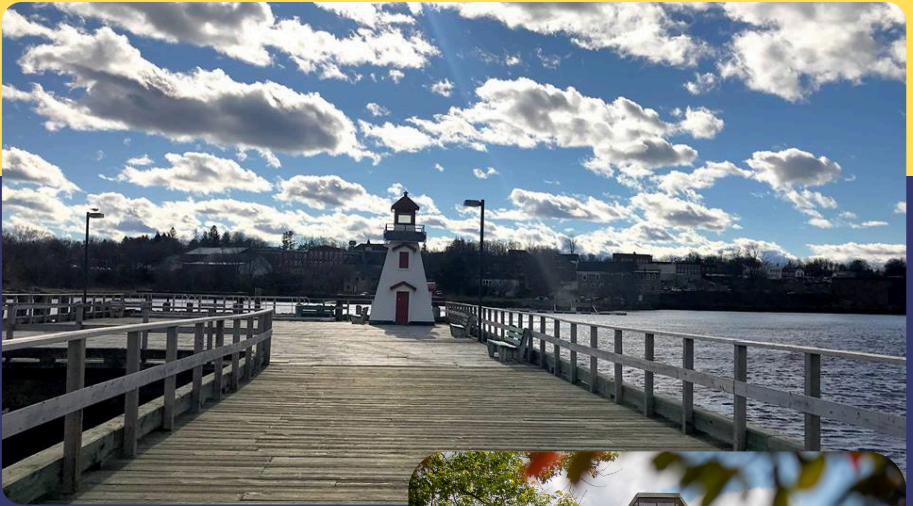

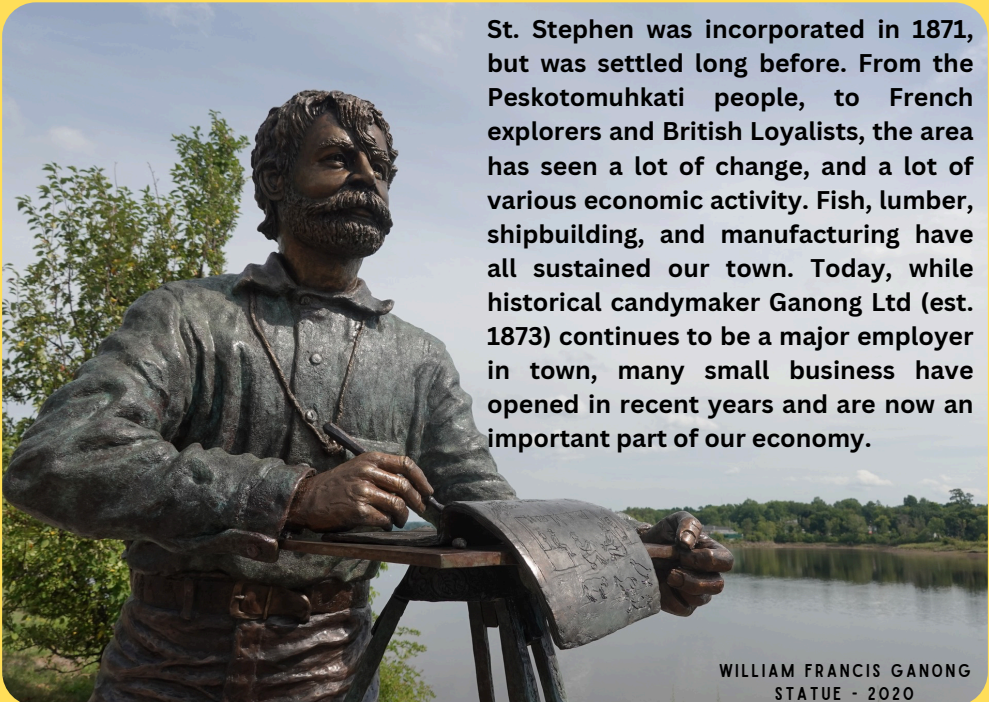

St. Stephen was incorporated in 1871, but was settled long before. From the Peskotomuhkati people, to French explorers and British Loyalists, the area has seen a lot of change, and a lot of various economic activity. Fish, lumber, shipbuilding, and manufacturing have all sustained our town. Today, while historical candymaker Ganong Ltd (est. 1873) continues to be a major employer in town, many small business have opened in recent years and are now an important part of our economy.

OUTDOOR FUN



Dover Hill Park

Dover Hill Park is one of St. Stephen's most photographed beauty spots. The view of the St. Croix River has been the backdrop for many graduation and wedding pictures - or wedding ceremonies! In the summer, take the trail down to the river's edge, where you can enjoy our urban oasis at the picnic tables and gazebo, or in the fall, take the trail along the river and find a serene spot to rest.

Courts & Fields

Come on out and play! Within the interior of the district, you'll find a basketball court in Milltown (next to the W.T Booth outdoor pool), a soccer field and baseball diamond at the Royal Canadian Legion on Queen Street West, 2 tennis courts on Queensway in Milltown at Memorial Park, as well as the many fields and diamonds owned by Anglophone South School District.



Elm St. Nature Park & Pet Valu Dog Park



Elm Street Park is a 60-acre wooded nature park located at the north end of Elm Street. The park is ideal for short hikes through the woods, dog walking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and biking. The trails are well marked and lead to Dennis Brook. There is no cost to use the nature park, and convenient parking is at the entrance. The off leash dog park is located within Elm St. Nature Park.

There are 5 playgrounds for children around the interior of the Municipal District area: David Alison Ganong Chocolate Park, Abbot Street Tot Lot, Elm Park Tot Lot, Milltown Elementary School, and St. Stephen Elementary School.

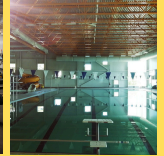
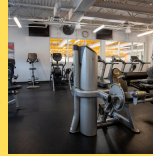
THINGS TO SEE & DO

The Garcelon Civic Center is the healthy living jewel in St. Stephen's crown! The facility includes the Quartermain Arena, which is an NHL-sized ice surface; the Sun Life walking track; a full conference centre for up to 250 people, a fitness centre, and an aquatic centre with both a 25-meter leisure pool and a therapy pool.

Fun Fact.... Team Canada's World Junior Championship team trained here in 2022 prior to winning their gold medal in the 2023 World Junior's Ice Hockey Championship.

This is one of the few arenas that keeps the ice in year-round, so join us for skating all summer long!

The Municipal Sports Lending Library is also located inside the building - check out the weekly skate schedule for more information.



W.T. Booth Outdoor Pool - 10 Mill Lane. St. Stephen's outdoor pool is the perfect way to cool down on a hot summer day! The main body of the pool is a long lap portion, with a connected shallow beach entry section that includes three different splash features and a water slide. Surrounding the pool is the main building with indoor change rooms and several picnic tables and benches. Admission to all swims (except aqua fitness classes and swim lessons) is completely free!



Located in Memorial Park at the corner of Queensway and Church Street, the Milltown War Memorial stands as a solemn tribute to the brave men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice in World War I, World War II, and the Korean Conflict. This meaningful site offers a place for reflection and remembrance, honouring the legacy and service of those who gave their lives in defence of freedom.



Cotton Mill Monument, Milltown Blvd, E3L 1J6. A proud part of the history of Milltown is the Cotton Mill and the key role it played in the economic development of our area. In 2007, The Milltown Cotton Mill Workers Monument was unveiled as a way to recognize the hard work and contributions of all the people who worked at the Mill during its 75 years of operation. While the mill is no longer there, the monument will carry its memory forward for future generations.

The recently renovated St. Stephen Wharf located at 2 Milltown Blvd features a beautiful lighthouse perfect for pictures; views of the Skutik/ St. Croix River & our neighbours across the way! A creative option for an outdoor wedding!



Walk along Milltown Boulevard and enjoy our small businesses, cafés, restaurants, and more! And don't forget to hit the Chocolatier - still in its original location since the 1800s!



St. Stephen is home to approximately 2 kilometres of the Coastal Link Trail, winding along the community's scenic waterfront on the beautiful St. Croix River. This well-loved pathway offers stunning views, fresh river air, and a peaceful setting that invites you to slow down and take it all in. A favourite for both residents and visitors, the trail is perfect for a leisurely stroll, a morning walk, or simply enjoying the natural beauty that defines the St. Croix Valley.

This Bateau was constructed on the occasion of the 125th anniversary of St. Stephen and is along the Coastal Link Trail. It is a replica of the boats used on the St. Croix River during log drives. Its design and stability allowed it to manoeuvre through falls, rapids, chuts and a sea of logs safely. It also provided shelter when turned over on shore.



The Time and Universe sculpture was created by John Gogaberishvili in 2014. The red stone, which is separated from the main composition, designates new innovative time. There are three other stones located around the sculpture, one that depicts the sunrise, another that represents the night and the third one is still untouched. Located near the Visitor Information Centre in Waterfront Park.

This bronze sculpture of William Francis Ganong was unveiled in St. Stephen in 2020. W. F. Ganong was a renowned scientist known for mapping New Brunswick's coastline, waterways, and mountains. There are maps engraved into the statue's back as a tribute to Ganong's love for his province. Located in Waterfront Park.



The War Memorial Cenotaph is designated a Local Historic Place as being a solemn remembrance of the soldiers who paid the supreme sacrifice in World War I, World War II and the Korean Conflict. Located just out front of St. Stephen's University on Milltown Blvd.



The Museum at 443 Milltown Blvd. has been a family home and a town hall before getting its name as the Charlotte County Museum in 1980. Since then, the museum has offered guided and personalized group and singular tours to our visitors. While also offering adult and kid friendly events/games while being completely free of charge. History needs no cost to enjoy!

The Loyalist Burial Ground is one of the oldest historic cemeteries in the region, resting place of early settlers who arrived following the American Revolution, including Captain Nehemiah Marks. Located on the east side of King Street—just steps from Downtown St. Stephen—this quiet site offers a meaningful glimpse into the community's earliest days. Carefully restored beginning in 2005, the grounds feature a mix of standing and ground-level headstones, some dating back to 1784, along with a memorial stone unveiled in 2008 to honour the area's founders.

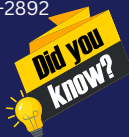

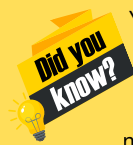
