



Clarification on definition of live music in bars/restaurants from the Regional Emergency Management Coordinator

Can Bars and/or Restaurants restart their Live Music?

Answer:

Response from Order Interpretation Team

A food and beverage-serving establishment which was previously permitted to present live music can continue to do so and is not considered a live music venue under the [Mandatory Order](#).

Businesses must meet or exceed the conditions identified in their [COVID-19 Operational Plan](#) which includes physical distancing, cleaning and disinfecting, hand and respiratory hygiene, and pre-screening for symptoms. Businesses must ensure they can safely manage operations. While the operational plan doesn't need to be approved by [WorkSafeNB](#) or [Public Health](#), it needs to be available at any time as it could be requested by either regulatory body.
